- Students will enroll in a total of 7 credits per year.
- Students recommended for Algebra will be identified in the spring of their 7th grade year; those students will be invited to enroll in Algebra instead of Math 8.
- Students may be placed in Math/Reading/Academic Intervention Support based on NWEA and/or other assessment scores, classroom performance, and teacher concerns; in grades 6-8 this will replace an Elective.
- Students with a current IEP may qualify for SRA reading classes in lieu of Electives.
- Support Study may be available for students with a current IEP. Please discuss this option with your SE Case Manager. Support Study may be offered in lieu of Electives.
- Students recommended for SE Math by their IEP will be enrolled in the level-appropriate class instead of their grade level Math course.
- All classes are assigned on the basis of class availability, maximum class loads, and special educational or medical needs.
- **Please remember that choosing alternatives is as important as making primary requests; classes requested may not be offered depending on overall demand and available staff.**
- Class schedules for 2023-2024 will be available 5-7 days before school begins (as possible).
